SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Colorado Pilots Association (CPA) may grant a flight training scholarship to one Certificated Flight Instructor (CFI) candidate per year. The CPA recognizes a robust population of active CFIs is essential to the health and growth of the pilot group within the state. The program is funded primarily from donations by individual members and revenues derived from the CPA's nationally recognized Mountain Flying Ground School.

Eligibility:

This scholarship will be awarded to a Colorado resident pursuing an initial CFI certificate at a recognized Colorado FAR Part 61/141 flight school. A letter of recommendation from the flight school, including a statement of enrollment in a formal course leading to a CFI certificate is required.

Disbursement of Funds:

Funds will be deposited in the scholarship winner's account at the flight school of choice. No funds will be issued to any individual. Funds may be issued in increments as requested by the winner, or may be transferred to another FAR Part 61/141 Colorado School as necessary. Certification from the new school will be required. Unused funds will be returned to the CPA.

Basis of the award:

The Scholarship committee will award the scholarship upon review of the application, letter(s) of recommendation, and a telephonic interview with the applicant. Emphasis will be given to applicants who intend to flight instruct for a minimum of one year.
